Rehabus

“Eligible Persons holding Hong Kong Identity Card” refer to:

- persons with disabilities (PWDs) who hold Hong Kong Identity Card issued under the Registration of Persons Ordinance (Chapter 177), except those who obtained their Hong Kong Identity Card by virtue of a previous permission to land or remain in Hong Kong granted to them and for whom such permission has expired or ceased to be valid;
- children with disabilities who are Hong Kong residents and under 11 years of age.

Note: To address the special needs of PWDs, PWDs can be accompanied by escorts when using Rehabus services. Rehabus has the right to terminate services to anyone who fails to pay fares.

1. Scheduled Route Service

* Routes using any of the following toll tunnels or bridges: Cross Harbour Tunnel, Eastern Harbour Crossing, Western Harbour Crossing and Lautau Link.

2. Dial-a-Ride Service

2.1 Charges: Taking into account of the number of passengers, fares are being charged on hours (minimum 1 hour) and kilometers, plus a service charge of HK\$5 per booking:

Effective from 1 October 2007

No. of Passengers	1 ~ 4	5 ~ 12	13 or above
Hourly Charge (HK\$): minimum 1 hour	\$24	\$38	\$58
After 1 hour, every 3 minutes charge (HK\$):	\$1.2	\$1.9	\$2.9
Kilometer Charge (HK\$)	\$1.2	\$1.9	\$2.9
