"Eligible Persons holding Hong Kong Identity Card" refer to:

- persons with mobility difficulties who hold Hong Kong Identity Card issued under the Registration of Persons Ordinance (Chapter 177), except those who obtained their Hong Kong Identity Card by virtue of a previous permission to land or remain in Hong Kong granted to them and for whom such permission has expired or ceased to be valid;
- children with mobility difficulties who are Hong Kong residents and under 11 years of age.

Note: To attend to the special needs of persons with mobility difficulties, they can be accompanied by escorts when using Rehabus services. Besides, Rehabus has the right to terminate services to anyone who fails to pay fares.

## 1. Scheduled Route Service

\* Routes travelling via Cross Harbour Tunnel, Eastern Harbour Crossing, Western Harbour Crossing or any of the tolled roads.

The fare for scheduled route service is determined by the customer's application and the final arrangements made, which define the category of pass:

- 1) If the customer applies for 5 or 6 trips per week and is arranged to use 5 or 6 trips per week, it is classified as "Half-Monthly Pass".
- 2) If the customer applies for more than 6 trips per week but is only arranged to use 5 or 6 trips per week (e.g., either only arranging in-bound trip or only the return bound trip), it is classified as "Half-Monthly Pass".
- 3) If the customer applies for more than 6 trips per week and is arranged to use more than 6 trips per week, it is classified as "Monthly Pass".

## 2. Dial-a-Ride Service

2.1 Charges: The preliminary fare quotation is based on the route provided by the customer and the travelling kilometers and estimated time from the technology of the digital mapping, Google Map [including the time that the bus captain to assist the passenger(s) to board or alight from the bus]. Details are as follows:
